

Should my child go to school/child care or camp today?

Your child should stay home if any of these situations apply:

- ❑ They were with someone with COVID-19, regardless of if they have symptoms
- ❑ Someone in your household is concerned they have COVID-19 and is getting tested
- ❑ They have a positive COVID-19 test
- ❑ They have one or more of the following symptoms:



Loss of Taste or Smell



Fever (100.4°F) or Chills



Concerning Cough



Trouble Breathing



Severe Headache



Severe Sore Throat



Vomiting



Diarrhea

- ❑ **Within 24 hours** if symptoms worsen or do not go away, do not go to school, call your health care provider for evaluation and/or a COVID-19 test.
- ❑ **Within 24 hours** if symptoms completely go away, your child may return to school. You do not need clearance from a healthcare provider or a COVID-19 test to return.
